

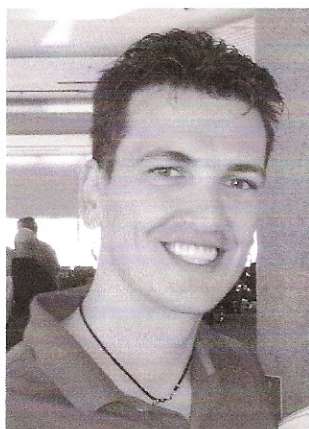
# LAURA WILKINSON FOUNDATION EXECUTIVES

Laura Wilkinson

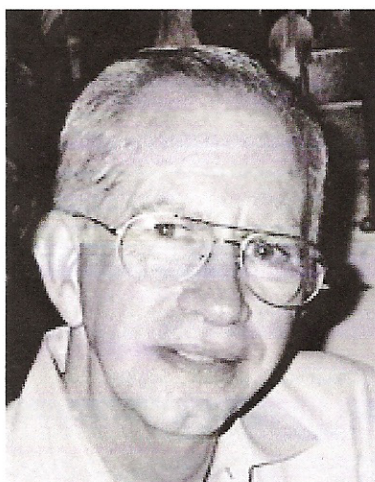
Laura is the only woman in history to win a gold medal in every major world competition in platform diving - 2000 Olympic Games, 2004 World Cup and 2005 World Championships. She has won two NCAA Division 1 titles, 8 All-American Honors, 4 Big XII titles, and 19 US National titles. Laura was voted by the American public the 2000 US Olympic Spirit Award winner and was nominated for an ESPY in 2000 for Female US Olympic Athlete of the Year. Laura graduated from the University of Texas in 2001 with a BS in Public Relations. She also has a background in gymnastics and dance.
